#### Candidate Qualities:

Determined/Growth Mindset:
 1<sup>st</sup> Interview: Could you tell me about a time when a patient you were treating wasn't improving like you thought they should be?
 2<sup>nd</sup> Interview: Could you tell me about what courses/CEUs you have attended/taken over the past year?

#### 2) Selfless/Understanding:

1<sup>st</sup> Interview: Could you tell me about a time when a coworker or classmate was going through a challenging situation. What happened and what did you do? 2<sup>nd</sup> Interview: What does the optimal blend of work and life outside of work look like to you?

1<sup>st</sup> Interview: Who was your last CI? (This is important: *ask them to spell it, and write it down*) When I talk to her/him, what will he/she say is your biggest weakness?  $2^{nd}$  Interview: Name a mistake you have made as a clinician and what you learned from it.

1<sup>st</sup> Interview: How was your relationship with your last Cl/boss? What is one thing you could have done to change that relationship?
